Children go downstairs to Binions Hall following the lighting of the orange candle. Children will return upstairs following the service.




Have you ever wanted to try a handbell? Are you interested to see what it is like on the other side of the tables?

Bob McRoberts - Big Walk for Leukemia


On May 29, Bob McRoberts, will walk from Union Station in Toronto to the Aurora Station, covering a distance of 42 km.
