

News From the EDGE

Church Community Update September 15, 2024



Welcome back summer travellers and staycationers! As we gather together with fresh new energy and focus on the changing season ahead, the EDGE Property Committee has updates to share on the building project that has been going strong all through the summer months.

The shape of the new Aurora United Church is gradually emerging through the steel structure and concrete forms that have been erected this past summer and the presence of the church is again becoming a landmark at Yonge and Tyler.

Here are some of the updates we are excited about:

- The sanctuary roof has been poured and the balcony tiers are in place and the continued progress of the rebuild is seen weekly
- The EDGE Property Committee is working in good relationship with AMICA to establish the groundwork for shared spaces like driveways and parking
- The installation of the glass is another major step ahead and we are on track to meet a winter deadline
- Our construction teams have found significant savings in alternative material choices
- Additional savings are being considered with some minor design changes

The EDGE Property Committee continues the work of monitoring the progress of the construction project and the Board of Trustees of AUC continue to keep a close eye on the funds available and to balance the costs of the construction progressing.
