ADVENT 1 (Hope) December 1, 2024 11:00 am

As the days grow shorter and the darkness grows, we light Advent candles each week to remind us that we do not face the darkness alone but that, indeed, the light of the world has come, shining on in the darkness to illumine our lives and lead us forward—not in fear, but in courage—even joy.

People, Look East
