Thursday, April 3rd – Thursday, May 22nd.

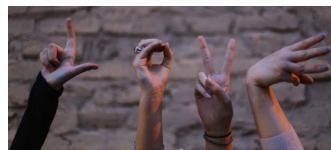

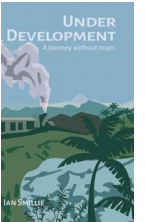
Children will return upstairs following the service.
